Winterton Surgical Unit offering Community Carpal Tunnel Service for Doncaster CCG

Here at the Winterton Medical Practice we have a purpose built Surgical Unit which opened in 1996.

Since 1998 the Surgical Unit has provided a community orthopaedic service under a contract with North Lincolnshire CCG. The Surgical Unit underwent a refurbishment in 2010 to bring it up to date with infection control standards. Since the unit opened we have provided the following procedures for patients in North Lincolnshire: Repair of Inguinal and Umbilical Hernia's, Carpal Tunnel Release, Cubital Tunnel Release, Trigger Finger Release, Dupuytren's Contracture, Excision of Ganglions (Hand/Wrist/Foot/Knee), Division of Palmar/Plantar Fascia, Canal of Guyon release, Primary Tenoylsis, Joint Injections, Circumcisions, Vasectomy's and Excision of Lesions/Cysts/Skin Tags. Our services are registered with the CQC.

Our premises are located in Winterton which is a small town north of Scunthorpe. This has easy access by road, our postcode for satellite navigation is: DN15 9TA. We have a carpark on site for patients' use which is free of charge. There are also bus routes to Winterton from Scunthorpe with two bus stops approximately 400 meters from us. There are bus and train routes from Doncaster to Scunthorpe.

COVID19

Additional Measures

We have introduced additional measures to keep patients and staff safe during the COVID19 pandemic:

- All patients are screened ahead of their appointment for Covid19 Symptoms
- All theatre staff will be wearing full PPE
- Patients must wear masks/face coverings while in the building
- All patients will be temperature checked ahead of surgery
- Hand washing facilities and hand sanitiser are located throughout the building and theatre
- Limited number of patients in the practice at a time
- One way system for surgical patients
